

## AGREEMENT

I hereby apply to become a participating physician and Associate Member of the New York State Troopers PBA Surgeons Group. I agree to accept the fees listed in the member's schedules as full payment for services to all active or retired members of the New York State Troopers PBA, their spouses, and eligible dependents. In the event that I chose to terminate this membership, I agree to notify the PBA in writing at least thirty days in advance of the effective date of termination. I understand that the NYSTPBA reserves the right to terminate my membership in the NYSTPBA Surgeons Group. I understand that if either my membership is discontinued for any reason, I will return all materials pertaining to the organization.

In the event I desire to advertise my status as an associate member of the New York State Troopers PBA, I agree to notify the NYSTPBA Board of Directors in advance and await approval.
